
## How to apply for course waiver


- 1. You need to log in to the UCAS Course System through this link <a href="http://ic-course.ucas.ac.cn/">http://ic-course.ucas.ac.cn/</a>
- 2. On the main UCAS Course System, click on Student Login



3. In field 1 enter the SEP Username, and in field 2 enter your SEP password. Then click Login




4. On the following page click on Register Courses



- 5. You can waive one, two, or all of the (China Panorama, Elementary Chinese1, Elementary Chinese2) courses by clicking on the **Apply for Waiver** if you meet one of the following two conditions:
  - A- Having an HSK Level 3 certificate or higher.
  - B- Obtaining a bachelor's or master's degree taught in Chinese.



6. After clicking on the Apply for Waiver button, a pop-up window will appear. You should click the **Choose File** button and upload the proof of your fulfillment of one of the mentioned conditions. Then click **Submit** 



7. Finally, confirm the application request by clicking the **OK** button



8. How to waive the course Academic Morality and Writing Norms?
Only for student who have got master degree at UCAS can apply to waive the course Academic Morality and Writing Norms. When you apply for it, pls upload your transcript at UCAS.
